Oct. 7	<u>2-Person Net Best Ball</u>	Play regular golf. Net best ball on each hole will count toward Couple's score.	Y	Two scores per hole per Couple
Oct. 14	<u>2-Person Low Net</u>	Play regular golf. Team score is based on the team total less total of team handicap	Y	Two scores per hole per Couple
Oct. 21	<u>2-Person – Pinehurst Alternate Shot</u>	Each player hits a tee shot. Select the best tee shot. Pick up the other ball. Players then alternate shots until the hole is finished.		One score per hole per Couple
Oct 28	<u>4 Person Low Net</u>	Play regular golf. Team score will be the total of 4 players less total of 4 handicaps.	Y	Four scores per hole for team of 4
Nov. 4	<u>4-Person Scramble – 3 Drives each</u>	Each player hits a tee shot. Select the best teeshot. ALL players will play from that spot (within one club length), but no closer to the hole. The process continues until the ball is holed.		One score per hole per team of 4
Nov. 11	<u>2- Person Low Net</u> <u>**Craft Fair – No social**</u>	Play regular golf.	Y	Two scores per hole per Couple
Nov. 18	<u>4-Person Shamble – 3 Drives Each</u>	Each player hits a tee shot. Select the best tee shot. Each player plays their own ball from that spot through the hole.		Four scores per hole per team of 4
Nov. 25	<u>4-Person Aggregate Scramble</u>	Each couple plays a 2-Person Scramble (6 drives each). Team net score is combined net score for each Couple.		One score per Couple per hole
Dec. 2	<u>4-Person Throw Out the 3 Worst Par 4 Holes</u>	Play regular golf. Select three worst par 4 holes and deduct from total 18-hole score	Y	Four scores per hole per team of 4
Dec. 9	<u>2-Person Low Net</u>	Play regular golf.	Y	Two scores per hole per Couple
Dec. 16	<u>4-Person Scramble – 3 Drives each</u>	See Nov. 4		One score per hole per team of 4
Dec. 23	<u>4-Person Best 9 Doubled</u>	Play regular golf. The best nine for each player is doubled.	Y	Four scores per hole per team of 4
Dec. 30	<u>2-Person Odds & Evens</u>	Play regular golf. Each couples score will include one net score from each hole. Guys net score on odd numbered holes, Gals net score on even numbered holes.	Y	Two scores per hole per couple
Jan. 6	<u>4-Person Aggregate Scramble by Handicap Pairs</u>	The two lowest handicap players play a 2-person scramble and the two highest handicap players play a 2-person scramble. The scramble scores are combined.		Two scores per hole per team of 4
Jan. 13	<u>2-Person Low Net</u>	Play regular golf.	Y	Two scores per hole per Couple
Jan. 20	<u>2-Person Chapman</u>	Each player tees off. Players then swap and hit each other's ball as a second shot. The better of the two balls is then selected and the players alternate shots till that ball is holed.		One score per hole per Couple

Jan. 27	<u>4-Person Low Net</u>	Play regular golf.	Y	Four scores per hole per team of 4
Feb. 3	<u>2-Person Scramble – 6 Drives Each</u>	All team members hit from the tee and select the best ball. After selecting your best shot, ALL players will play from that spot within one club length, but no closer to the hole. The process continues until the ball is holed.		One score per hole per Couple
Feb. 10	<u>4-Person Scramble – 3 Drives</u>	** See Nov 4		One score per hole per team of 4
Feb. 17	<u>4- Person - Designated Ball</u> ** Quilt Show – No social**	An event in which there is a “designated ball”. The players rotate the designated ball and the player with that ball has that score circled. The other players play their own ball. Record all scores. The team score for each hole is the sum of the designated ball and the best score of the other three players.	Y	Four scores per hole per team of 4. Mark the scorecard to show which player has the designated ball on each hole. Look for the sample cards in the Pro Shop.
Feb. 24	<u>4-Person Best Nine Doubled</u>	Play regular golf. The best nine for each player is doubled and handicap applied. The net scores are combined for the 4 players.	Y	Four scores per hole per team of 4

Mar. 17	<u>4-Person Scramble</u>	All team members hit from the teeing ground and select the best ball. After selecting your best shot, ALL players will play from that spot within one club length, but no closer to the hole. The process continues until the ball is holed.		One score per hole per team of 4
Mar. 24	<u>2-Person Trifecta</u>	Play 2-person best ball on holes 1-6, 2-person alternate shot on holes 7-12, 2-person scramble on holes 13-18.		One score per Couple per hole. Score like a scramble
Mar. 31	<u>4-Person 3 Clubs and a Putter</u>	Each player designates which 3 clubs will be used for the entire round. A putter is allowed on the green. No other clubs but the three designated can be used.		Four scores per hole per team of 4
April 7	<u>2-Person Net Best Ball</u>	Play regular golf. Net best ball on each hole will count toward Couple’s score.	Y	One score per hole per Couple
April 14	<u>4-Person Aggregate Scramble – Guys and Gals</u>	The guys play a 2-person scramble and the gals play a 2-person scramble. The scramble scores are combined.		Two scores per hole per team of 4
April 21	<u>2-Person Best Nine Doubled</u>	Play regular golf. The best nine for each player is doubled and handicap applied. The net scores are combined for each Couple.	Y	Four scores per hole per team of 4
April 28	<u>2- Person Low Net</u>	Play regular golf.	Y	Two scores per hole per Couple

Games with a Y under Hdcp are games in which gross score will be counted toward handicaps.

General rules about scoring: Unless specified otherwise, all competition in Couples League is net score. Here is how net scores are computed.

In 2-Person games

- **two balls are scored**, the combined gross score is reduced by the combined handicaps of the two players.
- **one ball is scored**, that gross score is reduced by $\frac{1}{2}$ of the combined handicaps of the two players.

In 4-Person games

- **four balls are scored**, the combined team gross score is reduced by the combined handicaps of the four players.
- **two balls are scored**, the combined team gross score is reduced by $\frac{1}{2}$ of the combined handicaps of the four players.
- **one ball is scored**, the combined team gross score is reduced by $\frac{1}{4}$ of the combined handicaps of the four players.

In 4-Person aggregate games

- the net score for the team is the combined net scores for the two couples. Those net scores are figures as described above for 2-Person scoring.
